On March 22, 2014 at 10:37 am, forty-three lives and a vibrant riverfront community were lost in an instant as mud and debris flowed down from the surrounding mountainside devastating the homes and rural highway. What was once a forested neighborhood along the river had been leveled, and what remained resembled a swampy moonscape like nothing any responder had ever seen before, resulting in the largest loss of life from a single event landslide in U.S. history. www.slidememorial.com
